



SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

Please pack in soft luggage and remember: 1) storage space is limited on a sailboat; and 2) we sail no matter what the weather!

CLOTHING

(as seasonally appropriate, but plan for temps 10o – 20o degrees cooler than forecast)

Essential

- Windbreaker
- Rain jacket (hooded, lightweight, waterproof, breathable)
- Rain pants (lightweight, waterproof, breathable)
- Boat shoes
- Fleece, puffer jacket, sweatshirt or sweater
- Sweatpants (fleece preferred)
- Hat (with strap) – wide-brimmed is best
- Long pants
- Shorts
- Socks
- Underwear
- Sleepwear
- Short/Long sleeve shirts
- Cover-up (from sun)
- Sunglasses with retention strap
- Mittens/gloves

Recommended

- Sailing gloves
- Water shoes (for wading on rocky shores)
- Walking shoes for ashore
- Casual dinner clothes for ashore
- Neck gaiter
- Swimsuit(s)
- Spare R eyewear (glasses or contact lenses)
- Spare sunglasses
- Lightweight hoodie

MISCELLANEOUS[‡]

Essential

- Bedding (at times supplied, you may prefer your own) – sleeping bag/sack, pillow & case
- Towel and face cloth
- Sunscreen – non-greasy/oily, SPF 30 or more, reef-friendly preferred
- Lip Balm – SPF rated
- Personal medications
- Toiletries

Recommended

- Insect repellent
- Ziploc bags – gallon and quart
- Backpack (small), day bag, and/or fanny pack
- Plastic laundry bag
- Dry bag
- Hand sanitizer – bottle or wipes

GEAR

Essential

- Extra batteries – for whatever needs them
- Charging cords – for whatever needs them
- Car charger adapter – for when not dockside

Recommended

- Personal water bottle
- Personal electronics – phone, tablet, laptop, etc.
- Waterproof cover for personal electronics

ALSO CONSIDER

- Earplugs
- Camera
- Music
- Small flashlight/headlamp
- Clothes pins
- Motion sickness medication
- Small sewing kit
- Eyeglass repair kit

[‡]Avoid glass containers, valuables, high-wattage appliances (i.e. hair dryers)
